From the Discernment Committee

In early December, Canon Kim Karashin shared a letter from Bishop Ketlen with the Senior Wardens and Discernment Committee co-chairs of St. Mark's and St. Francis in the Fields. There is a copy in this issue of the *Grapevine*. In the letter, the Bishop offered encouragement as we face the retirement of Mother Nancy and also offered the Diocese's assistance with our spiritual needs as we continue our search for a permanent priest-in-charge.

Thanks in large part to LisaBell-Loncella's response to Canon Kim that listed numerous concerns regarding the long-term potential for both parishes to be without a spiritual leader, Bishop Ketlen has agreed to hold a call with the Senior Wardens and Discernment Committee co-chairs to discuss these concerns and, hopefully, provide both parishes with a stronger commitment from the Diocese for not only assistance with our spiritual needs once Mother Nancy retires, but also to take a more active role in assisting us with our priest-in-charge search.

The call is scheduled for the afternoon of January 15 and we will provide an update at the January 18 annual parish meeting. Please continue to pray for the Discernment Committees of St. Mark's and St. Francis in the Fields and for the right candidate to receive a call to minister to our parishes.

ALL CREATURES GREAT AND SMALL

Another Year has come to an end here at the Pet Food Pantry. We began our Pet Food Pantry Campaign in early November and we are so thankful for those of you who gave to help keep our Pantry open. Because of your generosity, we will be able to keep our pantry open for another 4 or 5 months.

We are so grateful to all who continue to support our Pet Food Pantry. While there are too many to list here, each of you has received a personal letter from our Pantry Coordinators thanking you for your generosity.

During December, we assisted **127** Families, which included 10 new families and several walk-in emergencies.

We helped feed 194 dogs, 22 puppies, 580 cats, and 127 kittens.

We gave out over 1600 lbs of dog Food and Cat Food.

Through your generosity, we were also able to give out dog treats and cat treats.

We are grateful for all of our volunteers who continue to help us.

The Pantry will be open on **Thursday, January 8th from 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM.**
